- I am the Vice-chair of BOARS (the board of admissions and relations with schools) for UC systemwide and served as chair of UCR's Undergraduate Admissions Committee.
- I'm the president and co-founder of the Tongva Taraxat Paxaavxa Conservancy, our community's Land Back 501c3 that acquired the first land owned by us in almost 200 years.
